Group 1: Elected Officials, Senior Executives/Managers and Professionals

<i>Senior executives / managers</i> head large organisations or departments within them.
<i>Business</i> [chief executive, managing director, company secretary, finance director, chief accountant, personnel/industrial relations manager, research and development manager]
<i>Media</i> [newspaper editor, film/television/radio/stage producer/director/manager]
<i>Public Sector</i> [public service manager (Section head or above), regional manager, hospital/health services/nurse administrator, school principal, faculty head/dean, library/museum/gallery manager, research laboratory/facility manager, police/fire services Commissioner]
<i>Defence Forces</i> [Commissioned Officer]
<i>Professionals generally have degree or higher qualifications and professional experience in government, private industry or own business.</i>
<i>Health</i> [GP or specialist, registered nurse, dentist, pharmacist, optometrist, physiotherapist, chiropractor, veterinarian, psychologist, therapy professional, radiographer, podiatrist, dietician]
<i>Education</i> [school teacher, university lecturer, VET/special education/ESL/private teacher, education officer]
<i>Law</i> [judge, magistrate, barrister, coroner, solicitor, lawyer, legal officer]
<i>Engineering</i> [architect, surveyor, chemical/civil/electrical/mechanical/mining/other engineer]
<i>Science</i> [scientist, geologist, meteorologist, metallurgist]
<i>Computing</i> [IT services manager, computer systems designer/administrator, software engineer, systems/applications programmer]
<i>Business</i> [management consultant, business analyst, accountant, auditor, policy analyst, actuary, valuer]
<i>Social</i> [social/welfare/community worker, counsellor, minister of religion, economist, urban/regional planner, sociologist, librarian, records manager, archivist, interpreter/translator]
<i>Air/Sea Transport</i> [aircraft pilot, flight officer, flying instructor, air traffic controller, ship's captain/officer/pilot]

Group 2: Other Business Managers/Professionals and Associate Professionals

<i>Farm/Business Owner/General Manager</i> [crop and/or livestock farmer/farm manager, stock and station agent, building/construction, manufacturing, mining, wholesale, import/export, transport business manager]
<i>Specialist Manager</i> [works manager, engineering manager, sales/marketing manager, purchasing manager, supply/shipping manager, customer service manager, property manager]
<i>Financial Services Manager</i> [bank branch manager, finance/investment/insurance broker, credit/loans officer]
<i>Retail Sales/Services Manager</i> [shop, post office, restaurant, real estate agency, travel agency, betting agency, petrol station, hotel/motel/caravan park, sports centre, theatre/cinema, gallery, car rental, car fleet, railway station]
<i>Artist/Writer</i> [editor, journalist, author, media presenter, photographer, designer, illustrator, musician, actor, dancer, painter, potter, sculptor]
<i>Sportsperson</i> [sportsman/woman, coach, trainer, sports official]
<i>Associate professionals generally have diploma/technical qualifications and support professionals.</i>
Medical, science, building, engineering, computer technician/associate professional
<i>Health/Welfare</i> [enrolled nurse, community health worker, paramedic/ambulance officer, massage therapist, welfare/parole officer, youth worker, and dental hygienist/technician]
<i>Legal</i> [police officer, prison officer, government inspector, examiner or assessor, occupational/environmental health officer, security advisor, private investigator, debt collector, law clerk, court officer, bailiff]
<i>Business/Administration</i> [recruitment/employment/industrial relations/training officer, marketing/advertising specialist, market research analyst, technical sales representative, retail buyer, office manager, project manager/administrator, mail supervisor, other managing supervisors]

<i>Other</i> [library assistant, museum/gallery technician, research assistant, proof reader]

Group 3: Trades and Advanced/Intermediate Clerical, Sales and Service Staff

Tradesmen/women generally have completed a 4 year Trade Certificate, usually by apprenticeship. All tradesmen/women are included in this group.

Advanced/intermediate clerical, sales and service staff.

Recording Clerk [bookkeeper, bank clerk, PO clerk, statistical/actuarial clerk, investment accounting clerk, accounts/claims/audit clerk, payroll clerk, personnel records clerk, registry/filing clerk, betting clerk, production recording clerk, stores/inventory clerk, purchasing/order clerk, freight/transport/shipping clerk/dispatcher, bond clerk, customs agent/Clerk]

Inquiry/Admissions Clerk [customer inquiry/complaints/service clerk, hospital admissions clerk]

Office Assistant [secretary, personal assistant, desktop publishing operator, switchboard operator]

Sales Representative [company sales representative (goods and services), auctioneer, insurance agent/assessor/loss adjuster, market researcher]

Carer [aged/disabled/refuge care worker, child care assistant, nanny]

Service Staff [meter reader, parking inspector, postal delivery worker, courier, travel agent, tour guide, flight attendant, fitness instructor, casino dealer/gaming table supervisor]

Group 4: Other Occupations

Other clerical, sales and service staff.

Sales Staff [sales assistant, motor vehicle/caravan/parts salesperson, checkout operator, cashier, bus/train conductor, ticket seller, service station attendant, car rental desk staff, street vendor, telemarketer, sales demonstrator, shelf stacker]

Office Staff [typist, word processing/data entry/business machine operator, receptionist]

Hospitality Staff [hotel service supervisor, receptionist, waiter, bar attendant, kitchen hand, fast food cook, usher, porter, housekeeper]

Assistant/Aide [trades' assistant, school/teacher's aide, dental assistant, veterinary nurse, nursing assistant, museum/gallery attendant, home helper, salon assistant, animal attendant]

Machinery operators.

Driver or Mobile Plant Operator [car, taxi, truck, bus, tram or train driver, driving instructor, courier/ deliverer, forklift driver, street sweeper driver, garbage collector, bulldozer/loader/grader/excavator operator, farm/horticulture/forestry machinery operator]

Production/Processing Machine Operator [engineering, chemical, petroleum, gas, water, sewerage, cement, plastics, rubber, textile, footwear, wood/paper, glass, clay, stone, concrete, etc production/processing machine operator]

Other Machinery Operator [photographic developer/printer, industrial spray painter, boiler/air-conditioning/refrigeration plant, railway signals/points, crane/hoist/lift, bulk materials handling and machinery]

Defence Forces [other ranks (below senior NCO) without trade qualification not included above]Other agriculture, horticulture, forestry, fishing, mining worker [farm overseer, shearer, wool/hide classer, farm hand, horse trainer, nurseryman, greenkeeper, gardener, tree surgeon, forestry/logging worker, miner, seafarer/fishing hand]

Other Worker [labourer, factory hand, storeman, guard, cleaner, caretaker, laundry worker, trolley collector, car park attendant, crossing supervisor.

Group 8: Unemployed greater than 12 months
